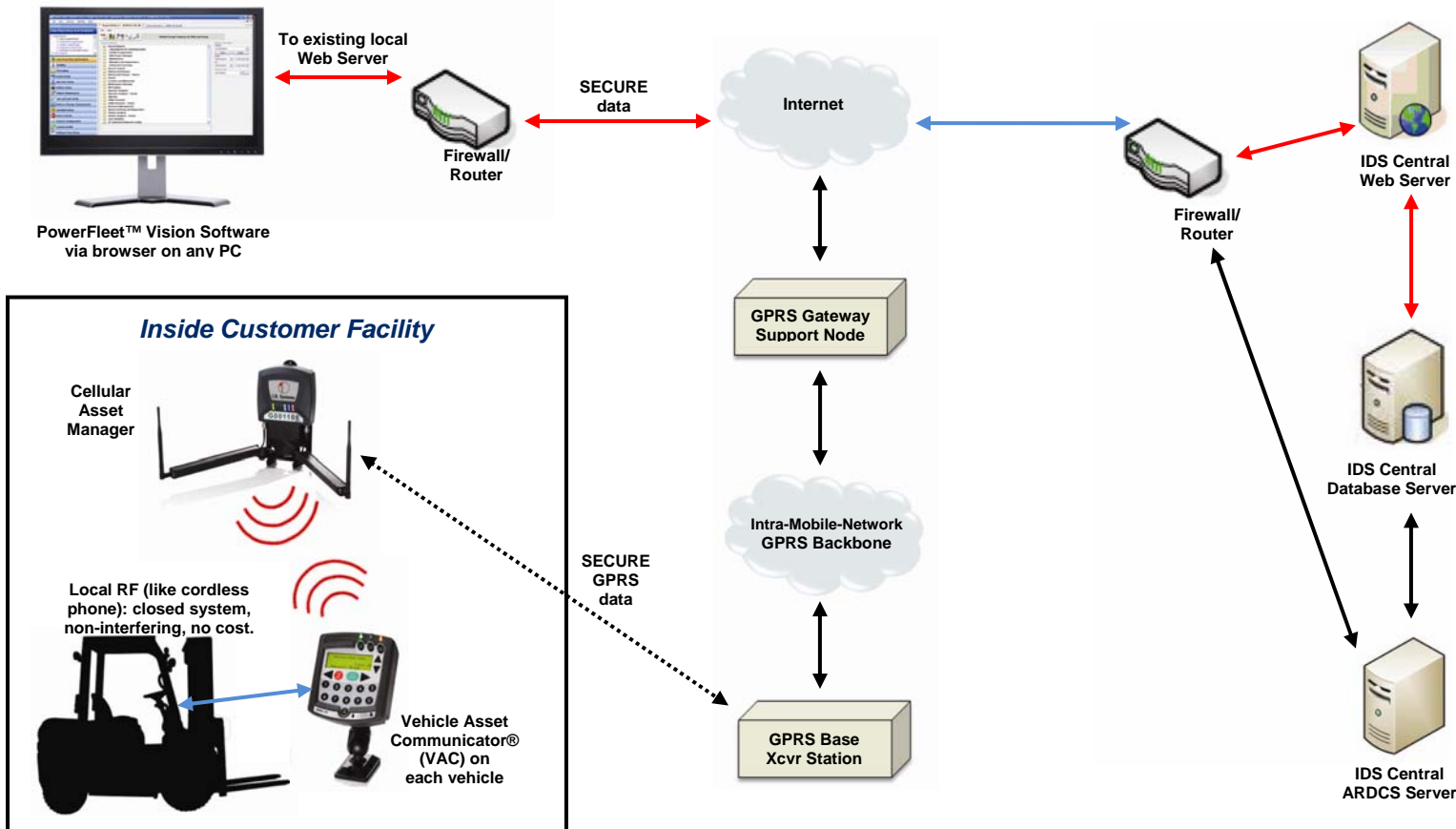

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How big does my fleet need to be to justify PowerBox?

PowerBox can provide economic value for fleets as small as 10 vehicles, and there is no limit to how big the fleet can be. PowerBox can handle an unlimited number of vehicles and operators. For fleets of less than 10 vehicles, you should consider a simple non-wireless solution for driver identification and impact sensing, like our didBOX™ system.

Q: What makes PowerBox different?

1. PowerBox is designed and built by I.D. Systems, which, for more than 15 years, has successfully deployed wireless asset management technology for the world's leading manufacturers, distributors, retailers, airlines, and government agencies. Engineered with this unique expertise, PowerBox is extensively pre-configured, so it is easy to install and launch, and quick to generate benefits for you right out of the box.
2. PowerBox is a hosted system, with a browser interface and automatic reporting, so you don't need any complicated IT support or extensive training to implement and run the system. You can focus on the benefits from day one.
3. PowerBox is billed monthly as a simple subscription service, like your mobile phone; it does not require any upfront cash outlay, so you do not have to go through a capital purchase justification, and you can "save as you go," with the system more than paying for itself every month.

Q: What's the coverage/term of the PowerBox subscription?

Everything is covered: hardware, software, support, maintenance, hosting, and cellular communications—for the entire subscription term of either 36 or 60 months.

Q: What happens at the end of the subscription term?

You can continue using the system for a substantially reduced subscription fee, at the then-current rate, to cover nominal hosting, licensing and cellular communications costs. Or, you can upgrade to an entirely new system, with state-of-the-art technology, at the then-current full subscription rate.

Q: Is PowerBox easy to install? How long does it take?

Q: What software installation does PowerBox require?

PowerBox is accessed through whatever ordinary browser you use (typically Internet Explorer, Firefox, or Netscape) after installing a Citrix ICA client plugin or a Java plugin, both common off-the-shelf tools. PowerBox can also be accessed through iPads using the Citrix app.

Q: Does PowerBox affect my facility's wireless network?

No, PowerBox has ZERO impact on wireless local area networks, and requires ZERO local IT support.
